

Old Glory Coasters

SUPPLIES (PER COASTER):

- Two 6" x 6" pieces red-striped fabric
- One 3¾" x 2¼" piece blue fabric
- One 6" x 6" piece cotton or polyester batting
- Matching thread
- Needle
- Scissors
- Pins
- Sewing machine

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Set sewing machine to a tight zig-zag stitch and sew small blue piece to corner of one red-stiped piece to create the front of the coaster.
2. Pin the front, back and batting together as follows: Place front on back with right sides together. Place front and back on top of batting and pin all four sides.
3. Sew around edge of coaster using a ¼" seam; leave a 2" opening in the bottom. Turn coaster inside out and handstitch opening closed.
4. Display in a woven basket on the dining table, use one as padding beneath a glass vase, or feather into your decor in any spot that needs a little patriotic perk-up!
