

## Scaredy-Cat Cup

### Supplies:

- National Nonwovens wool felt:
  - 12" x 12" piece of Reet's Relish for outer cup
  - Copper Kettle: one 12" x 12" piece for inner cup and one 4" x 5½" piece for moon
  - 3" x 5" piece of Black for cat
  - 1½" x 1½" piece of Old Gold for star
- ½ yard of ½"-wide black grosgrain ribbon
- 12" x 12" piece of Warm and Natural needled cotton quilt batting
- #8 DMC Pearl Cotton embroidery floss in Black and Light Gray
- Freezer paper
- Air-soluble marker
- Pencil
- Tracing paper
- Scissors
- Iron
- Straight pins
- Sewing machine and matching thread
- Embroidery needle
- Candy and small gifts for filling cup

### Instructions:

*Note: Wash wool felt before you begin. Wet fabric thoroughly and wring, or spin out water in washing machine. Dry in dryer on permpress setting. Wool felt will shrink 1"-2". Some colors will run. Visit [www.cloft.com](http://www.cloft.com) for more cup patterns from JAM Patterns.*

1. Cut one cup pattern from Reet's Relish for outer cup. Cut one cup pattern from Copper Kettle for inner cup. Cut one cup pattern from batting.

2. Transfer star, moon and cat patterns onto freezer paper. Iron slick side of paper onto wool felt. Cut one moon from Copper Kettle, one cat from Black and one star from Old Gold.

3. Pin batting to wrong side of outer cup piece. Position moon, cat and star on center of outer cup. *Note: Seam will be on back side of cup.* See photo. Hand stitch moon, star and cat into place using Black floss.

4. Add dotted line from moon to star with Black floss



and a running stitch. Stitch nose in Light Gray floss using a satin stitch. Straight stitch eyes, whiskers and mouth with Light Gray floss.

5. If desired, backstitch HALLOWEEN with Black floss.

6. Trim batting about ¼" in from top edge of outer cup. Batting should not be visible on outer cup.

7. With right sides together, fold outer cup

in half lengthwise and machine sew back seam. Repeat for inner cup.

8. Turn outer cup right side out. Insert inner cup into outer cup with wrong sides together. Line up top edge of cups. Sew together with Black floss using a blanket stitch.

9. Knot each end of grosgrain ribbon about ¾" from edge. Hand stitch knots on each side of cone. Secure firmly.

10. Fill cup with small gifts or candy.
