

## Lovely Toile Table

### Supplies:

- Coffee table with a lip
- Fine- and medium-grade sandpaper
- Tack cloth
- Black and cream acrylic craft paints
- Paintbrushes
- Toile stencil or white-and-black patterned toile wallpaper
- Antiquing glaze in brown
- Soft rag
- Polycrylic sealer
- Glass cut to fit tabletop

### Instructions:

1. Using medium-grade sandpaper, sand piece to prep surface for painting. Remove dust with a tack cloth.

2. Paint tabletop, legs and side rails black. Let dry. Paint tabletop and edges cream. Let dry.

3. Using fine-grade sandpaper, sand table edges to expose black base coat, and sand legs and side rails to expose wood.

4. To create toile tabletop, either use a toile stencil and black acrylic paint, or cut a piece of toile wallpaper to fit tabletop. Stencil pattern following manufacturer's



instructions. If using wallpaper, distress it before adhering to tabletop by tearing small holes in it and sanding it lightly. Adhere wallpaper to tabletop following manufacturer's instructions.

5. To further distress pattern, apply a small amount of antiquing glaze to a rag, and wipe glaze lightly around tabletop's edges. Blend

glaze in to table center.

6. To protect finish, apply sealer to entire piece. Let dry. If desired, have a piece of glass cut to protect tabletop from spills.
